User training: Updates for experienced Rapida users

Koenig & Bauer supports users with prior Rapida experience with a training concept tailored to their individual needs. In our predominantly practice-oriented seminars, which focus above all on changes to the presses already used by the participants, there is ample opportunity to explore new press options through first-hand experience and to practise the handling of new functions.

Description

The name Koenig & Bauer has always stood for quality printing press manufacture and innovative solutions serving the print industry. Accordingly, we have many customers who have been loyal users of our sheetfed offset presses for many years. This seminar is geared specifically to such users, who have already gained extensive experience with a previous Rapida generation and are now moving on to one of the latest Rapida models. The participants possess corresponding prior knowledge, but wish to acquaint themselves with the additional functionalities of the new press ahead of the production start.

Key areas of the training are the console environment and the installed measuring systems. Taking into account the precise level of prior knowledge and experience, the seminar is tailored specifically to the participating customers, in order to concentrate solely on those press features and functions which are new to them or have changed significantly. Use of the new possibilities can also be practised during the printing of a number of corresponding jobs.

Objectives

The participants are familiarised with differences between the current Rapida generation and their existing press. They are able to operate the new press and can make use of the new options and installed measuring systems in daily production practice.

Prerequisites

As qualification for this advanced training, participants should have gathered at least 2 years of printing experience with a predecessor generation.

- · New features for the feeder, infeed, printing units, coater and delivery
- Frequent activities such as blanket and plate changing under new conditions
- Removal of a complete roller train, replacement and roller adjustment

Changes to software solutions

- New console and its operating panels
- ErgoTronic and QualiTronic, basic introduction to expanded measuring system functionality
- operation with CIPLinkX or LogoTronic Professional
- Further options and updates

Processing of print jobs

- Loading of job data and preparations for the production of different jobs
- Hands-on practice with the new solutions
- Optimisation of processes

Training methods

- Face-to-face training with comprehensive training documents which can also be made available in digital form at the end of the training upon request.
- · Almost exclusively practical training.
- Direct presentation without translation in German, English and Spanish. Further languages subject to prior agreement.
